The public is invited to an information meeting being held so that ratepayers may review and discuss the following items:

Extension of high-speed Internet service (Broadband) in the Burnstown area of the Township of McNab/Braeside

When: Saturday, May 15th, 2010

Time: 2:00 to 4:00 p.m.

Where: Neat Café - 1715 Calabogie Road in Burnstown

Bell representatives will be on-hand to address details of the current Broadband project. Six (6) areas within the townships of McNab-Braeside and Admaston-Bromley are directly involved.

DSL high-speed Internet service has already been extended to areas of Russett Drive, Braeside, Sand Point and White Lake. Bell Aliant expects high speed service to begin in the Burnstown area by the end of May and Douglas (in Admaston/Bromley) by the end of July.

The overall project is valued at more than \$987,000.00 and includes approximately one-third funding from the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs (OMAFRA) under its "Rural Connections" Broadband Program.

Discussions at the May 15th Public Information Session will include details of the technology being installed, the areas being served, project time-lines and subscriber costs.
