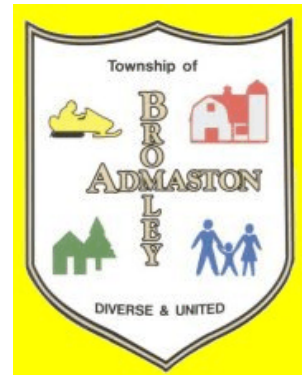

**Extension of high-speed Internet service (Broadband) in the  
White Lake area of the Township of McNab/Braeside**

**When: Wednesday, February 3, 2010**

**Where: White Lake Fire Hall, 142 Burnstown Rd., White Lake.**

Bell representatives will be on-hand to address details of the current Broadband project. Six (6) areas within the Townships of McNab-Braeside and Admaston-Bromley are directly involved.

DSL high-speed Internet service has already been extended to areas of Russett Drive, Braeside and Sand Point. Bell Aliant expects high speed service to begin in the White Lake area this February, with Burnstown scheduled to follow later this summer.

The overall project is valued at more than \$987,000.00 and includes approximately one-third funding from the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs (OMAFRA) under its "Rural Connections" Broadband Program.

Discussions at the February 3rd Public Information Session will include details of the technology being installed, the areas being served, project time-lines and subscriber costs.
